IRE396H1 Research Participation

Credit course for supervised participation in a faculty research project. Offered only when a faculty member is willing and available to supervise. Not eligible for CR/NCR option.

Prerequisites: IRE244H1, IRE260H1 and an average of at least 70% in 1.0 credit in IRE at the 300+ level. Approval of the Program Coordinator.

Breadth Requirements: Society and its Institutions (3)

Eligibility and Requirements

Open only to IRHR Students (ASMAJ1536, ASSPE1536).

Additional requirements:

1. Credit course for supervised research in a faculty research project.
2. Students must contact CIRHR Faculty member (Research or Teaching Stream only) to inquire about such opportunities. See list [here](#) and contact Faculty directly.
3. Students may not complete more than 1.0 credits in IRE396H1
4. Research Ethics Approval: All course-based human research involving human participants must be submitted through the My Research Human Protocols (MRHP) system, effective January 3, 2024. <https://research.utoronto.ca/ethics-human-research/submit-human-ethics-protocol>
5. Approval of UG Program Coordinator required. Forms must be submitted for consideration by the deadline. Decision will be communicated to student via email.

1. Complete section 1; complete section 2 and 3 with supervisor.
2. Return application form to Silvia Cocolo, Program Coordinator, silvia.cocolo@utoronto.ca no later than 2 weeks before the start of term in which the IRE396H1 will be undertaken.
